Dear Ms. McCauley:

Pursuant to Ordering paragraph 1 of Public Utilities Commission of Ohio's ("Commission") April 2, 2015 *Entry* in the above-referenced matter, The New Knoxville Telephone Company ("NKTC") submits this Letter affirming its compliance with 47 C.F.R. §51.911, *inter alia* requiring competitive local exchange carriers to set intrastate terminating switched exchange access rates no higher than the carrier's corresponding interstate rates no later than July 1, 2013.

NKTC's Ohio intrastate switched access rates are set at parity to its corresponding interstate rates, as set forth in the Company's P.U.C.O. Tariff No. 1 submitted in Case No. 13-0866-TP-ATA. In that revision, NKTC set to zero all rate elements not contained in its interstate tariff and expressly mirrored its interstate services for the remainder. Accordingly, NKTC's switched access rate amendments are already in compliance with the requirements of PUCO Case No. 10-2387-TP-COI and have been since 2013.
