ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On March 20, 2015, ABA Energy Partners, Inc. (ABA) filed an application for certification as a competitive retail natural gas broker/aggregator.
- (2) In accordance with R.C. 4929.20 and Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-27-10, ABA's application is subject to a 30-day automatic approval process. Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-27-10 further provides that, upon good cause shown, the Commission or an attorney examiner may suspend certification of a certificate application. If an application for certification is suspended, the Commission shall act to approve or deny the application within 90 days of the suspension.
- (3) The attorney examiner finds that good cause exists to suspend the 30-day automatic approval process with respect to ABA's application for certification, in order that the Commission and Staff may review this matter further.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the automatic approval process for ABA's application for certification as a competitive retail natural gas broker/aggregator be suspended. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon each party of record in this case.
