The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On January 28, 2015, the Commission issued an Entry directing all reporting companies to file their 2014 annual reports for fiscal assessment using the on-line filing system by April 30, 2015, or to file for an automatic 30-day extension in this docket.
- (2) To date more than 1,000 reports have been successfully filed using the on-line system. However, Staff is concerned that, due to technical issues, some companies may not have been able to file or did not receive appropriate notice of their filing obligations. Accordingly, a blanket 30-day extension should be granted to allow Staff additional time to ensure that any technical issues have been resolved, and that all regulated entities have been contacted regarding their filing obligations. Accordingly, any company that has not yet submitted its 2014 annual report will be granted until June 1, 2015, to do so.
- (3) All reporting companies are reminded that a \$1,000 civil forfeiture may be assessed, pursuant to R.C. 4905.54, against any company failing to comply, absent good cause shown.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That each reporting company be granted until June 1, 2015, to file its annual report. It is, further,

ORDERED, That notice of this Entry be served directly upon each reporting company that holds a certificate or operating authority for which no 2014 annual report has been submitted or request for extension has been filed. It is, further,

ORDERED, That notice of this Entry be sent to the Electric-Energy, Gas-Pipeline, Railroad, Telephone, and Water industry listserves.
