Protesters wary of anti-abo

COLUMBUS — About 100 protesters chanted on the steps of the Statehouse on Wednesday, seeking to prevent a repeat of two years ago when a number of anti-abortion provisions were slipped into the state budget at the last minute. Stretching down the steps and onto the plaza below them were 2,000 pairs of sneakers, high-heels, sandals, boots, and

other shoes.

"Many of the [Statehouse] opponents have never walked in our shoes, and until they do they can't understand what women face today," said Rep. Teresa Fedor (D., Toledo). She surprised her House colleagues in March when she announced that she had an abortion after being raped decades ago while serving in the military. She made the comments during debate on a bill

that would all but prohibit abortion once a fetal heartbeat is detected.

"I have felt the same since that day, and I'm sure that freedom goes with that freedom go," Teresa Fedor (D., Toledo) said. "There's empowerment, freedom, and I feel more women and men had to address this their families to speak The National Council on Jewish Women/Cleveland Planned Parenthood


