Ohio Power Company (AEP Ohio) is in the final stages of implementing its second Electric Security Plan (ESP II) authorized by the Commission in Case Nos. 11-346-EL-SSO et al. Throughout the term of ESP II, AEP Ohio filed the Fuel Adjustment Clause (FAC), the Fixed Cost Rider (FCR) and Auction Phase-In Rider (APIR) quarterly with the rates going in effect the month after filing unless otherwise ordered by the Commission. On June 1, with the Compliance tariffs of the ESP III (Case Nos. 13-2385-EL-SSO et al), the APIR and FCR rates will be set to zero. But the Company still needs to do a final true up of the APIR and the FCR for January through May 2015.

After conferring with Staff, the Company plans to file one final true-up of the APIR and FCR through the FAC mechanism after the actual costs incurred through May 2015 become known, rather than filing the first quarter update on June 1 and filing the final two months later.
