# SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT PROJECTION ASSUMPTIONS AND ACCOUNTING POLICIES

These financial projections present, to the best of management's knowledge and belief, the Company's expected financial position, results of operations and cash flows for the projection periods. Accordingly, the projections reflect management's judgment, as of June 8, 2015, the date of these projections, of the expected conditions and its expected course of action. The presentation is designed to assist the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio in the Competitive Retail Electric Service (CRES) certification process. The assumptions disclosed herein are those that management believes are significant to the projections. There will usually be differences between projected and actual results, because events and circumstances do not occur as expected, and those differences may be material.

#### **Note 1. NATURE OF OPERATIONS**

Total Energy Resources, LLC, located in Cranberry Township, PA, was developed with the goal of assisting commercial and industrial customers with their energy requirements, natural gas companies with the management and/or sale of their production, and leaseholders with the development of their acreage. The Company has forty years of management experience and knowledge in the energy sector.

#### Note 2. SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The Company's policy is to prepare its financial statements on the income tax basis of accounting. The Company's fiscal year end is December 31.

All tax events of the Company's income or loss are passed through to the members individually; thus, this statement includes no income tax expense or benefit for the Company.

Depreciation expense is calculated using the modified accelerated cost recovery system required by the Internal Revenue Code.

Loan costs are amortized using the straight-line method over the term of the loan to which costs correspond.

Inventory consists of marketable natural gas.

Cash and cash equivalents include demand deposits, savings accounts, and investments with a maturity of three months or less.

#### **Note 3. SALES ASSUMPTIONS**

The Company is on track to experience a 10% increase to Net Income for 2015 and is projecting an additional 10% increase in Net Income for 2016. These increases are the result of the sale of gas inventories that were purchased at reduced costs in 2014 and continue into 2016 based on historical growth and expectations.

#### Note 4. OWNERSHIP CHANGES

In 2015, one of the two partners of the Company retired from operations. The statements reflect a partial reduction in Member Distributions and Guaranteed Payments for 2015, and a full reduction for his share of Member Distributions and Guaranteed Payments for 2016.

#### Note 5. SALARIES, WAGES AND RELATED COST ASSUMPTIONS

For the years ended December 31, 2015 and December 31, 2016, the Company expects Salaries and Wages to increase. As a result of one Members' departure, the Company's Junior Partner will be assuming an increased role in the management of the company and receive increased compensation based on increased sales projections.

#### Note 6. OTHER OPERATING EXPENSES ASSUMPTIONS

Most Operating Expenses are expected to remain level for the years ended December 31, 2015 and December 31, 2016.

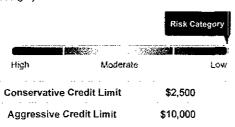

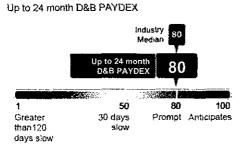

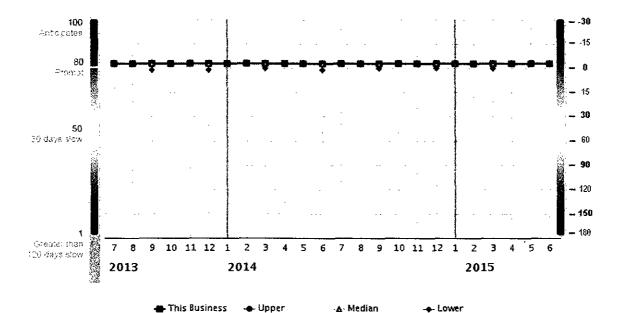

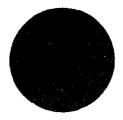

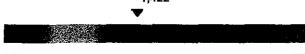
