PETITION OF TELEPORT COMMUNICATIONS AMERICA, LLC FOR REVIEW OF A
DECISION OF NEUSTAR - POOLING ADMINISTRATOR

An Ohio customer, University Hospitals, has requested 3000 numbers in the Akron rate center. University Hospitals is acquiring multiple physicians' practices and is integrating these locations into the University Hospitals' enterprise system. In order to maintain the integrity of their existing internal dialing plan, University Hospitals is requesting that the NXX NOT be of the format NX0, NX1 or NX9. This request is reflected in the customer letter. Teleport has developed a communications plan that University Hospitals will implement, and will subsequently assign the 3000 numbers within 180 days of the numbers being made available to the enterprise.

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PA.¹ On June 11, 2015, Teleport submitted a “Thousand Block Application Form Part 1A”, and a “Months-to-Exhaust and Utilization Certification Worksheet – TN Level” (“MTE and Utilization”) to the PA² using the Pooling Administration System (“PAS”). Teleport requested 3 number blocks in the Akron rate center and subsequently received an error message indicating the request would not process via the system without a state waiver.³ The PA, applying FCC rules and INC Guidelines, requires a block holder requesting growth resources to demonstrate that existing resources in the rate center will both exhaust within 6 months and meet the 75% utilization level. The error message included calculations indicating that the utilization threshold was NOT met.

Although Teleport has adequate telephone numbers, in this rate center, to satisfy incremental requests, without receiving additional numbers, the inventory cannot satisfy the customer’s specific need for 3000 numbers in the format 330-NX2 – 8. Teleport has 330-44-5, 330-849-3 and 330-983-0 in the Akron rate center, with approximately 600 numbers available in total. Therefore, Teleport needs to obtain the number blocks in order to satisfy the customer’s request. The Akron number pool has 26 blocks in the pool, 18 of which satisfy the 330-NX2 format.

The FCC's rules identify a procedure whereby denial of a numbering resource request can be brought to the appropriate state commission for review. 47 CFR § 52.15(g)(3)(iv) provides as follows:

(iv) The NANPA shall withhold numbering resources from any U.S. carrier that fails to comply with the reporting and numbering resource application requirements established in this part. The NANPA shall not issue numbering resources to a carrier without an Operating Company Number ("OCN"). The NANPA must notify the carrier in writing of its decision to withhold numbering resources within ten (10) days of receiving a request for numbering resources. The carrier may challenge the NANPA's decision to the appropriate state regulatory commission. The state regulatory commission may affirm or overturn the NANPA's decision to withhold numbering resources from the carrier based on its determination of compliance with the reporting and numbering resource application requirements herein.

In addition, the FCC's December 12, 2001 Order in its Number Resource Optimization Report and Order, CC Docket No. 99-200, FCC No. 01-362, paragraph 64 states that, "States may not accommodate requests for specific numbers (i.e. vanity numbers), but may grant requests for customers seeking contiguous blocks of numbers." Teleport submits that University Hospitals request constitutes special circumstances and demonstrates a clear requirement that warrants the Ohio Commission's review and reversal of NeuStar's decision.

Attached to this request are copies of Teleport's Thousand Block Application Form, the Months-to-Exhaust Certification, a copy of NeuStar's denial (Exhibit A), and a copy of University Hospital's letter of intent (Exhibit B).

For the reasons set forth herein, Teleport respectfully requests that the Commission overturn NeuStar's denial and direct NeuStar to assign the requested numbers in the Akron rate center to Teleport for use by University Hospitals.

Instructions for filling out each Section of the Part 1A form:

Section 1.1 Contact information requires that Service Providers supply under "Block Applicant" the company name, company headquarters address, a contact within the company, an address where the contact person may be reached, in addition to the correct phone, fax, and e-mail address. The Pooling Administrator section also requires the Service Provider to fill in the Pooling Administrator's name, address, phone, fax and e-mail.

Section 1.2 Service Providers who need a thousands-block assignment or for an Location Routing Number (LRN) are required to fill in this section. If needed for an LRN, a CO Code Application needs to also be submitted to the PA. The Service Provider should supply the Numbering Plan Area (NPA); the Local Access Transport Area (LATA), which is a three-digit number that can be found in the iconectiv™ LERG™ Routing Guide. The Operating Company Number (OCN) assigned to the service provider and the OCN its parent company. An OCN is a four-character alphanumeric assigned by iconectiv Telecom Routing Administration (TRA). In addition, the number of thousands-blocks requested should be supplied. The Switch Identification as well as the city or wire center name, rate center, rate center sub zone, homing tandem and CLLI™ tandem of the facilities based provider^{xi}. Explanations of these terms may be found in the footnotes.

Section 1.3 The date the Service Provider completes the application should be entered in this section, as well as the Effective Date of the requested thousands-block.

Section 1.4 Service Providers should indicate their type, e.g., local exchange carrier, competitive local exchange carrier, interexchange carrier, CMRS. The also indicate the primary type of business in which the numbering resource is to be used. Service Providers also may indicate their preference for a particular thousands-block, e.g., 321-9XXX, or indicate any thousands-blocks that may be undesirable, e.g., 321-6XXX.

Section 1.5 Service Providers indicate the type of request. Initial requests are for first applications for thousands-blocks in a rate center, growth for additional thousands-blocks in a rate center in which the applicant already has numbering resources, and provide the required evidence as ordered by the FCC.

Section 1.6 Service Providers must indicate the updated/current information in regards to contaminated TNs on the block they are returning to the pool. Blocks with over 10% contamination (101 TNs or more) shall not be returned to the pool unless they meet criteria outlined in section 9.1.2 of these Guidelines. This letter of Intent represents a request by University Hospitals for 3000 TN's for SIP service. University Hospitals intends to order service in the Akron, Ohio rate center, pending AT&T's successful completion of the required testing. University Hospitals intends to activate these numbers within 180 days from AT&T's receipt of the numbers.

University Hospitals is expanding to multiple locations in the geographic area covered by area code 330, and continues to grow. University Hospitals has acquired multiple physician practices and physical locations, and continues to add to that number, and within the next 1 to 2 years will need integrate their phone systems into the enterprise system. In the past year, in addition to the medical center, we have added numerous physician practices in the same geographic area, and in the next 1 to 3 years we expect to affiliate with additional practices in the same geographic area that will also need to be integrated into the enterprise phone system. In order to provide to provide administrative, physician offices, research, administrative, lab space and other system services with phone we require a consecutive block of 3000 TN's.

To meet the needs of our dial plan we need a block of TN's where the prefix does not start with a 0, 1 or 9, i.e., 330-NxX-xxxx, where X cannot be 0, 1 or 9). The numbers will be installed as TN's on SIP trunking located at 11100 Euclid Ave., Cleveland, OH 44106, within 180 days from AT&T's receipt of numbers. We expect that this block will meet our requirements for at least the next three years. We do not anticipate returning any numbers to AT&T.

AT&T is our service provider and we understand that they might escalate this request to the state utility commission.
