ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) Generally, pursuant to R.C. 4905.26, the Commission has authority to consider written complaints filed against a public utility by any person or corporation regarding any rate, service, regulation, or practice relating to any service furnished by the public utility that is in any respect unjust, unreasonable, insufficient, or unjustly discriminatory.
- (2) The Toledo Edison Company (TE) is a public utility as defined in R.C. 4905.02 and, as such, is subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission.
- (3) On January 28, 2015, Michael Grenier (Complainant) filed a complaint against TE, alleging, among other things, that TE has improperly charged Complainant for electric service on an account that should have been deactivated.
- (4) By Entry issued February 19, 2015, TE was granted an extension of time, until March 9, 2015, to file its responsive pleading in this case. On March 9, 2015, TE filed a motion to dismiss based on TE's claim that the dispute had been resolved between the parties.
- (5) Subsequently, on April 24, 2015, both of the parties jointly filed a motion to dismiss the complaint with prejudice, stating that the parties have reached a settlement in this proceeding.

- (6) The Commission finds that the parties' joint motion to dismiss with prejudice is reasonable and should be granted. Accordingly, the complaint should be dismissed.

It is, therefore,


ORDERED, That this complaint be dismissed with prejudice and closed of record. It is, further,






