### PETITION OF TELEPORT COMMUNICATIONS AMERICA, LLC FOR REVIEW OF A DECISION OF NEUSTAR - POOLING ADMINISTRATOR

Teleport Communications America, LLC ("Teleport"), by its attorney and pursuant to 47 CFR § 52.15(g)(3)(iv), respectfully requests that the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio ("Commission") review and overturn the Pooling Administrator's ("PA" or "NeuStar") denial of Teleport's request for numbering resources, as more fully described herein.

An Ohio customer, University Hospitals, has requested 1000 numbers in the Chardon rate center. University Hospitals is expanding its practices, research, lab and administrative space for the Hospitals' enterprise system. In order to maintain the integrity of their existing internal dialing plan, University Hospitals is requesting that the NXX <u>NOT</u> be of the format NX0, NX1 or NX9. This request is reflected in the customer letter. Teleport has developed a communications plan that University Hospitals will implement, and will subsequently assign the 1000 numbers within 180 days of the numbers being made available to the enterprise.

The Chardon rate center, in the 440 area code, began number pooling in April 2002 and therefore number acquisition by a Number Pooling carrier is gained through an interface with the PA.<sup>1</sup> On August 20, 2015, Teleport submitted a "Thousand Block Application Form Part 1A", and a "Months-to-Exhaust and Utilization Certification Worksheet – TN Level" ("MTE and

Utilization") to the PA<sup>2</sup> using the Pooling Administration System ("PAS"). Teleport requested 3 number blocks in the Chardon rate center and subsequently received an error message indicating the request would not process via the system without a state waiver.<sup>3</sup> The PA, applying FCC rules and INC Guidelines, requires a block holder requesting growth resources to demonstrate that existing resources in the rate center will both exhaust within 6 months and meet the 75% utilization level. The error message included calculations indicating that the utilization threshold was NOT met.

Although Teleport has adequate telephone numbers, in this rate center, to satisfy incremental requests, without receiving additional numbers, the inventory cannot satisfy the customer's specific need for 1000 numbers in the format 440-NX2 – 8. Teleport has only the 440-214-6 block with approximately 800 numbers available. Therefore, Teleport needs to obtain the number blocks in order to satisfy the customer's request. The Chardon number pool has 2 blocks available but only 1 of the blocks conforms to the required format 440-NX2-8.

The FCC's rules identify a procedure whereby denial of a numbering resource request can be brought to the appropriate state commission for review. 47 CFR § 52.15(g)(3)(iv) provides as follows:

(iv) The NANPA shall withhold numbering resources from any U.S. carrier that fails to comply with the reporting and numbering resource application requirements established in this part. The NANPA shall not issue numbering resources to a carrier without an Operating Company Number ("OCN"). The NANPA must notify the carrier in writing of its decision to withhold numbering resources within ten (10) days of receiving a request for numbering resources. The carrier may challenge the NANPA's decision to the appropriate state regulatory commission. The state regulatory commission may affirm or overturn the NANPA's decision to withhold numbering resources from the carrier based on its determination of compliance with the reporting and numbering resource application requirements herein.

In addition, the FCC's December 12, 2001 Order in its Number Resource Optimization Report and Order, CC Docket No. 99-200, FCC No. 01-362, paragraph 64 states that, "States may not accommodate requests for specific numbers (i.e. vanity numbers), but may grant requests for customers seeking contiguous blocks of numbers." Teleport submits that University Hospitals request constitutes special circumstances and demonstrates a clear requirement that warrants the Ohio Commission's review and reversal of NeuStar's decision.

Attached to this request are copies of Teleport's Thousand Block Application Form, the Months-to-Exhaust Certification, a copy of NeuStar's denial, and a copy of University Hospital's letter of intent (Exhibit B).

For the reasons set forth herein, Teleport respectfully requests that the Commission overturn NeuStar's denial and direct NeuStar to assign the requested numbers in the Chardon rate center to Teleport for use by University Hospitals.

If the block being returned is over 10% contaminated the PA shall seek a new block holder. If question c and/or d have a response of No, the request for return shall be denied. The thousands-block applicant certifies veracity of this form by signing their

University Hospitals intends to order service in the Chardon rate center, pending AT&T's successful completion of the required testing. University Hospitals intends to activate these numbers within 180 days from AT&T's receipt of the numbers.

University Hospitals has existing operations throughout this rate center, and continues to expand in the geographic area covered by area code 440. As new services are established University will need integrate their phone systems into the enterprise system. In the next 1 to 3 years we expect to affiliate with additional practices in the same geographic area that will also need to be integrated into the enterprise phone system. In order to provide to provide administrative, physician offices, research, administrative, lab space and other system services with phone we require a consecutive block of 1000 TN's.
