# SUPPLEMENTAL APPLICATION OF THE DAYTON POWER & LIGHT COMPANY FOR APPROVAL OF A REVISED BILL FORMAT FOR ELECTRIC SERVICE AND FOR APPROVAL OF CERTAIN ACCOUNTING AUTHORITY

- 1. Applicant the Dayton Power and Light Company (DP&L) is a public utility and electric light company as defined by R.C. § 4905.02 and § 4905.03(A)(4) respectively, and an electric distribution utility as defined by R.C. § 4928.01(A)(6) and is subject to the jurisdiction of the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio (the Commission).
- 2. On November 21, 2014, DP&L filed its initial Application for approval of a bill format revision pursuant to the March 26, 2014 Finding and Order and May 21, 2014 Entry on Rehearing in Case No. 12-3151-EL-ORD and O.A.C. Sections 4901:1-10-22(C) and 4901:1-10-33(F).
- 3. DP&L, after discussion with Commission Staff, filed an Amended Application to update its bill format on February 27, 2015.
- 4. On April 8, 2015, the Commission's Finding and Order approved DP&L's proposed bill format revisions and request for approval of authority to defer expenses related to

the bill format revisions. The deferral was capped by the Commission at \$500,000 with carrying costs, based on DP&L's estimate of "approximately \$500,000" to complete the project.

- 5. DP&L filed an Application for Rehearing of the April 8, 2015 Order on May 8, 2015 for rehearing of the \$500,000 deferral cap, which was granted in part by the Commission in its Entry on Rehearing ordered June 3, 2015. DP&L was ordered to file a supplemental application showing a breakdown of its updated estimated costs to implement the revised bill format.
- 6. Pursuant to finding 19 of the June 3, 2015 Entry on Rehearing, DP&L is seeking approval to defer the below prudent expenses related to the bill format changes. DP&L estimates these expenses to be approximately \$578,000. A breakdown of the estimated costs is shown below:

Billing System Support/System Changes	\$397,042
Bill Print and Mailing Services	\$94,500
Electronic Bill Presentment Vendor	\$21,000
Carrying Costs	\$65,448
Total O&M Estimate	\$577,990

#### **CONCLUSION**

DP&L respectfully requests that the Commission approve this Supplemental Application to revise DP&L's estimate and grant authority for the Company to defer expenses related to the proposed bill format enhancements, as shown above.
