ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) R.C. 4905.04 provides that the Commission has statutory authority to regulate and promote the welfare and safety of railroad employees and the traveling public.
- (2) R.C. 4907.471 provides that the Commission shall survey all grade crossings and establish a priority list to determine which grade crossings are in need of additional protective devices.
- (3) CSX Transportation, Inc. (CSX) is a railroad as defined in R.C. 4907.02 and subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission under R.C. 4905.04.
- (4) On December 17, 2014, the Commission issued a Finding and Order authorizing funding for several CSX projects, installation of mast-mounted flashing lights and roadway gates in Union County, city of Marysville, Industrial Parkway, DOT#513832K. CSX was directed to complete the project by September 17, 2015.
- (5) On July 23, 2015, CSX filed a request for a three-month extension of time to complete the project. CSX explains that miscommunication between CSX signal engineering and the construction group delayed placement of the project on CSX's construction schedule. CSX adds that construction is proceeding with the wiring of the signal house and purchase of materials.
- (6) Staff filed a memorandum on August 4, 2015, recommending that the Commission grant CSX's request.


- (7) The Commission finds that the circumstances described by CSX, in addition to Staff's recommendation, warrant the requested extension. Therefore, we find that the request for additional time to finish the project, which shall be completed no later than December 17, 2015, should be granted.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That CSX's request for additional time is granted, with the project to be completed no later than December 17, 2015. It is, further,




