AEP Ohio Transmission Company (AEP Ohio Transco) proposes to construct a new 138-kilovoti (kV) transmission line in Monroe Township in Harrison County and Orange Township in Carroli

The purpose of the Yager-Azalea 138-kV Transmission Line Project is to provide additional electricity to Utica East Ohio Midstream, LLC's, gas processing facility. AEP Ohlo Transco will but the new line using standard single circuit 138-kV structures. The Yager-Azalea 138-kV transmissio line will be approximately five miles long. This will build project will be an approximate \$10 million investment by AEP Ohio Transco. Construction is scheduled to begin in April 2016.



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
