To Whom it May Concern:

This letter is to inform you that Duke Energy Ohio, Inc., (Duke Energy Ohio) will file an application for an increase in rates with the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio (Commission) on or before March 1, 2016. The application will propose an increase in rates of approximately \$800,000 for Rider ASRP – Accelerated Service Line Replacement Program Rider for Duke Energy Ohio's gas distribution service to be effective in May 2016. This increase will result in an additional charge of \$0.14 per month for residential customers and represents an increase in Duke Energy Ohio's gas rates of approximately 0.2% of currently existing rates.

Consistent with federal pipeline safety regulations, Duke Energy Ohio has proposed its Accelerated Service Line Replacement Program to replace approximately 58,000 pre-1971, metal and other non-protected steel service lines, in an accelerated time period.¹ This program will reduce overall program costs and minimize disruption to and outages for customers. Duke Energy Ohio proposes that the ASRP be implemented over an accelerated period of ten years, beginning in 2015. Over the ten-year period, the Company projects the total capital and operations & maintenance expenditures under the ASRP to be approximately \$320 million, assuming 3 percent inflation and including relocating interior meters to an outside location and the reconnaissance costs on an additional 28,000 service lines.

I have enclosed a list of the proposed new rates. These rates are subject to change after the Commission holds public evidentiary hearings. Although this letter is a formal notice to you, in accordance with Ohio public utility law, we also have representatives available to discuss our rate proposal. If you have any questions about our rate proposal, please call our Rates Department at (513) 287-2370 and we will respond to your inquiries.

If you have other questions regarding our service, please call your Duke Energy Ohio customer service manager. As always, we value your role as our customers and as the elected representatives of the communities we serve.




