* Because Ohio's energy efficiency and renewable energy programs saved customers \$1.03 billion from 2009-2013 (source: Duke, FirstEnergy and AEP) and because the legislature froze those programs in 2014;

* Because Ohio's investments in renewable energy created 33,000 jobs (source: Ohio Development Services Agency) and then stalled due to the freeze on Ohio's renewable energy programs;

The Avondale Community Council supports denial of a consumer bailout of coal and nuclear plants that might otherwise close AND supports adoption of state policies that accelerate the transition toward greater energy efficiency and use of clean, renewable energy sources.
