ENTRY

The Commission finds:


- (1) Commission Staff served a notice of preliminary determination upon MC Trucking Company, Inc. (MC Trucking), in accordance with Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-12, alleging a violation of the Commission's transportation regulations.
- (2) On February 27, 2014, MC Trucking requested an administrative hearing in accordance with Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-13.
- (3) On March 7, 2014, the attorney examiner issued an Entry scheduling a prehearing conference for April 3, 2014. The parties participated in the conference but were unable to resolve matters.
- (4) On November 24, 2014, the attorney examiner issued an Entry scheduling a March 24, 2014 hearing. At the parties' request on January 26, 2015, the hearing was continued to April 10, 2015. However, on April 6, 2015, the parties requested another continuance to a date to be determined, because a witness for Staff was temporarily unavailable. On April 7, 2015, the attorney examiner issued an Entry granting the continuance request.
- (5) On November 9, 2015, Staff filed a motion to dismiss. Staff states that upon review and consideration of the matter, it *recommends dismissal and closure of the case.*
- (6) The Commission finds that Staff's motion to dismiss the matter and close the case is reasonable and should be granted.

It is, therefore,


ORDERED, That Staff's motion to dismiss the matter and close the case is granted. It is, further,


ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties of record.


