ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) On August 6, 2015, Craig Herendeen requested an administrative hearing in accordance with Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-13.
- (2) By Entry issued August 25, 2015, a prehearing conference was scheduled for September 11, 2015. However, just before the conference was to take place, counsel for Craig Herendeen informed the attorney examiner that his client had paid the civil forfeiture.
- (3) On September 11, 2015, Staff filed a letter confirming that Mr. Herendeen had paid the civil forfeiture.
- (4) Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-22 provides that payment of the forfeiture shall terminate all other proceedings regarding that violation.
- (5) In view of payment of the forfeiture, this case should be closed.




ORDERED, That this case be closed. It is, further,


ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties of record.
