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**MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT OF  
MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF THE CERTIFICATE**

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West Chester Township is a governmental aggregator certified by the Commission since January 8, 2006 to provide governmental aggregation services. West Chester Township's current certificate (06-133E(5)) expires on January 8, 2016. Pursuant to O.A.C. § 4901:1-27-09(B), West Chester Township seeks an extension of the current certificate pending renewal of the certificate by the Commission. West Chester Township has been in the process of transitioning brokers and CRES suppliers for the township's governmental aggregation program for retail electricity, and for this reason the applicant was unable to file its renewal application in the time period set forth in O.A.C. § 4901:1-27-09(A).

An extension of the certificate is warranted in this case. West Chester Township is actively working with its new broker and CRES supplier to complete and file its renewal application. Due to the transition, additional time is necessary to complete the renewal application and obtain the necessary approval from the township's board of trustees. The next meeting of the board of trustees will take place in two (2) business days, on January 12, 2016, at which time it is expected that the board will approve the renewal application. West Chester Township's renewal application will be filed as expeditiously as possible following the necessary approval from the board of trustees.

This motion for extension is not made for purposes of delay. Instead, the applicant seeks to fully comply with all of the Commission rules and certification requirements, and the delay in

the filing of the renewal application is due to the broker and supplier transition taking place in connection with the township's governmental aggregation program. Wherefore, West Chester Township respectfully requests that the Commission extend the current certificate (06-133E(5)) until such time that the Commission can consider the renewal application that will be filed in the near future following approval by the applicant's board of trustees.
