When sewage disposal service has been discontinued in accordance with these Rules and Regulations the entire bill, plus an additional charge of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for reconnection must be paid before service will be restored to the same customer. No charge will be made for connection of a new customer at the same premises.

B. Unmetered Customers

- Under normal conditions, a bill for an unmetered customer

 The due and payable within fifteen (15) days after
 the mailing of such bill. When service to any premises,
 lot or facility is established on a date between such
 quarterly billing periods, the customer shall be charged
 a per diem pro rata amount based on the rate for this
 class of service until commencement of the following
 billing period.
- 2. When an unmetered customer permanently terminates service during a quarter, the charge for the quarter shall be prorated on a per diem basis, and the customer shall be reimbursed for any sums paid in advance upon such per diem basis.
- 3. Bills unpaid thirty (30) days after the date of the mailing shall subject the premises, lot or facility to discontinuance of service. Notice of past-due bills will be mailed to customers, and sewage disposal service may be terminated by the Company in accordance with the procedures for discontinuance of service set forth in these Rates, Rules and Regulations.
