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                    DIRECT EXAMINATION
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     By Mr. McNamee:
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- Q. Mr. Schweitzer, could you state and spell your name for the record, please?
- A. My name is James W. Schweitzer, spelled S-C-H-W-E-I-T-Z-E-R.
- 5 Q. By whom are you employed and in what 6 capacity?
 - A. I am employed by the Public
 Utilities Commission of Ohio, and I am a Public
 Utilities Administrator 2, working in the rates
 and analysis department.
- Q. Okay. What is your business address?
- A. 180 East Broad Street, Columbus,
 Ohio 43215.
- Q. Okay. On the desk in front of you,

 Mr. Schweitzer, you will find two documents.
- 17 Let me ask you to turn you attention to what's
- 18 been marked for identification as Staff Exhibit
- 19 1. There is a letter to the docketing division
- 20 on the cover. Do you see that?
- 21 A. Yes.

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- Q. Good. Do you know what that is?
- 23 A. Yes.
- Q. What is it?
- 25 A. It is Staff's comments or Staff's

- recommendations following the audit of the filing may my Duke Energy of Ohio.
- Q. Was that prepared by you or under your direction?
 - A. Yes.

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- Q. Okay. Can you describe generally what those recommendations were?
- A. Within this document, obviously this document is covering both the Rider DR-IM, which is for the electric side of Duke's business, and Rider AU, which is the natural gas side of Duke's business.
 - And it outlines some recommended adjustments that we found in our view could be necessary in this particular case. And those adjustments resulted in the recalculation of the rates that were filed originally by Duke.
- Q. Okay. Let me have you turn your attention to Joint Exhibit 1, the other document.
- 21 A. Yes.
- Q. Do you know what that is?
- 23 A. Yes.
- 24 O. What is it?
- 25 A. It is the Stipulation and

- Recommendation made by all the parties in this
 particular case pulling together all of the
 comments, adjustments, made by Staff,
 suggestions made by other entities, including
 OCC, in this particular proceeding, resulting in
 a resolution to the matters that were outlined
 in this case.
 - Q. So, in your view it addresses all the concerns in the case, including adopting the various recommendations made by Staff?
- 11 A. Yes.

- Q. And it resolves all the issues in the case; does it not?
- 14 A. Yes.
- Q. Good. Let's talk about that
 stipulation just a bit more. You are familiar
 with the signatory parties to that document; are
 you not?
- 19 A. Yes.
- Q. Okay. You have worked with them for many years?
- 22 A. Oh, yes.
- Q. You believe them to be well
 informed, capable people able to represent the
 interests of their principals?

A. Absolutely.

- Q. Good. And the process of developing the stipulation was open and was participated in by all of the parties; yes?
 - A. Yes, it was.
- Q. Good. Does the stipulation in your view advance the public interest? Is this a good thing?
 - A. It is a good thing, yes.
 - Q. In what respect?
- A. The Company has invested significant dollars in modernizing its electric infrastructure and natural gas infrastructure. This resolution, this stipulation resolves the issues that resulted in a lot of benefits going to the customer from these investments, but at the same time results in the Company being able to recover its costs.
- So, it's balancing both the needs of the Company with the benefits being received by the customer.
- Q. Thank you. Let me ask you sort of the flip question, I guess. Does this stipulation in your view violate any important regulatory policy or principle?

14 1 Α. No. 2 In fact, it does the opposite; does Q. 3 it not? That's correct. 4 Α. 5 MR. MCNAMEE: Thank you. That is 6 all the questions that I have. And Staff would 7 move for the admission of Staff Exhibit 1 and Joint Exhibit 1. 8 9 ATTORNEY EXAMINER: Very good. Are 10 there any questions of this witness? 11 No questions, your MS. WATTS: 12 Honor. 13 MR. ETTER: No questions. 14 MS. MOONEY: No questions. 15 ATTORNEY EXAMINER: Very good. I 16 will admit Staff's Exhibit into evidence at this 17 time. And OCC's and the Company's as well. 18 (EXHIBITS ADMITTED INTO EVIDENCE) 19 ATTORNEY EXAMINER: Any other 20 matters to be taken care of?

2.1 MR. MCNAMEE: No, your Honor. I 22 believe that resolves all the issues in the case 23 for all the parties. 24 ATTORNEY EXAMINER: Very good.
