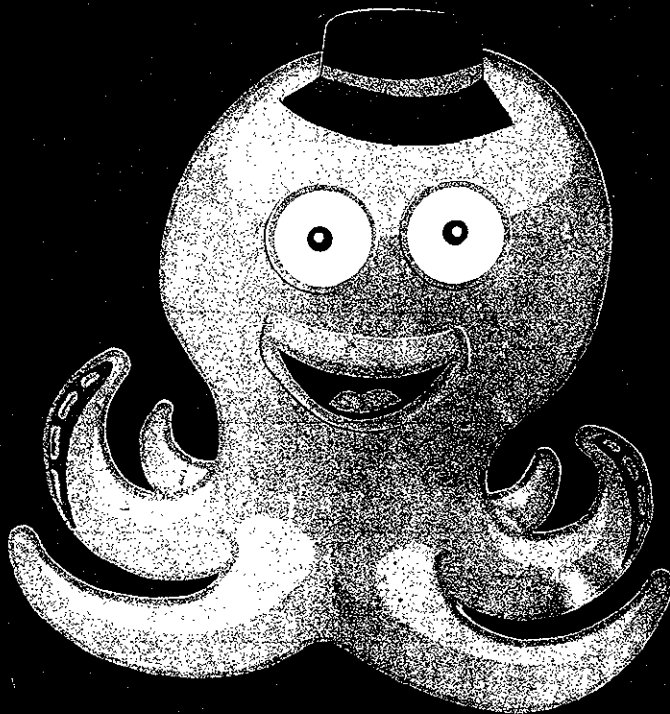
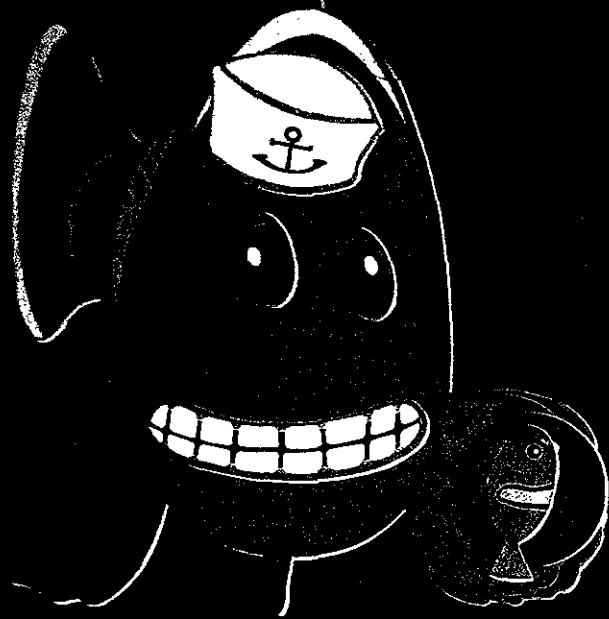
I am writing to express my concern over FirstEnergy's new proposed Electric Stability Plan, case number 14-1297-EL-SSO. I believe it is a mistake to force Ohio electric consumers to subsidize failing or uncompetitive businesses and plants. Ratepayers have already paid billions of dollars as part of the transition to a more deregulated generation market, and now that FirstEnergy subsidiaries can no longer compete, it strikes me as the worst kind of bailout to now ask customers for even more money to keep those subsidiaries competitive.

While I would ideally love to see a switch to cleaner sources of energy, I believe the best solution is to allow free market rates to prevail for all sources of energy, so that no one business or generation method is unfairly promoted through subsidies, and I believe FirstEnergy's attempts to gain such favor for itself and its subsidiaries should be rejected.
