We cannot encourage - or even allow - the power companies to use old out-dated polluted technology.

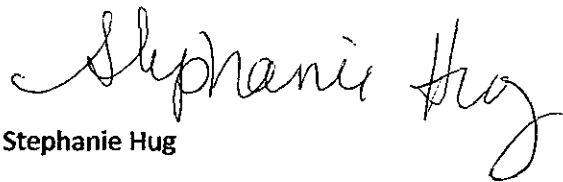

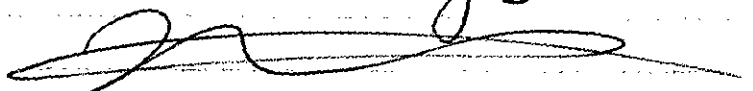
The global warming debate is over - unless we act soon our children & grand children will look to us in our old age & wonder why we didn't act when we had a chance.

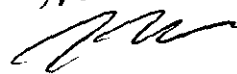

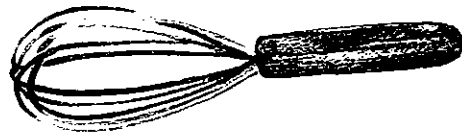
