Exhibit C

Narrative Summarizing Change(s)

In this application, Nova Telephone Company requests BLES pricing flexibility in order that it may increase its BLES rates for residential customers in the Nova Telephone Company exchanges. The Nova Telephone Company has two exchanges: Nova exchange and Sullivan exchange in which a pricing increasing is requested for both the Nova Exchange and Sullivan Exchange, as summarized in Exhibit B, to individual access line rate.

In the FCC USF/ICC Transformation Order (FCC 11-161), the FCC states that they want to avoid situations where some customers are subsidizing the cost of service for those that pay local service rates that are significantly lower than the national urban average. The FCC will therefore limit high cost loop support where local end-user rates do not meet an urban rate floor. In order to continue to receive full high cost loop support, Nova Telephone Company is required to have local rates that are comparable to the national urban average.
