

SUMMARY

On March 8, 2016, Glenwood Energy of Ohio, Inc. (Glenwood or Company) filed an application seeking approval of two transportation agreements. The first agreement is with McCullough-Hyde Memorial Hospital and the second is with The Square D Company.

The two agreements provide for the transportation of customer owned gas from Glenwood's interconnect at the Millville Station on the Texas Eastern Transmission Corporation's interstate pipeline, through Columbia Gas Transmission and Duke Energy Ohio, Inc. systems and finally across Glenwood's system. The agreements include administrative charges, general service rates, late payment fees, supplemental transportation rates, public and MCF taxes and imbalance provisions. The initial term of the agreements is through June 2018, and year to year thereafter unless terminated in writing 6 months prior to the end of term.

STAFF REVIEW

Staff reviewed the application filed in the above case and found the agreements to be reasonable and in the public interest.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends, to the Commission, that the application filed by Glenwood be approved.
