ANSWER

FIRST DEFENSE

- 1. DEO admits that Complainants are residential customers receiving natural gas service at 648 Broad Blvd., Cuyahoga Falls, Ohio 44221 (the Premises).
- 2. DEO avers that third-party contractors installed gas lines on behalf of DEO on or around the Premises during the time period referenced in the Complaint.
- 3. DEO is without sufficient knowledge or information to admit or deny the remaining allegations in the complaint, and generally denies any allegations not specifically admitted or denied in this Answer in accordance with Ohio Adm. Code 4901-9-01(D). DEO neither attests nor concedes to the authenticity of any document attached to the Complaint.

AFFIRMATIVE DEFENSES

SECOND DEFENSE

4. The complaint does not comply with the Commission's rules requiring "a statement which clearly explains the facts." Ohio Adm. Code 4901-9-01(B). The allegations are not in numbered-paragraph, but narrative, form; many of the allegations and statements in the complaint are compound; and many of the allegations omit numerous details necessary to answer them. The Company, has attempted, to the best of its ability, to answer the allegations, but reserves the right to amend its answer in the event it has incorrectly understood the allegations.

THIRD DEFENSE

5. The claims alleged in the complaint are not within the subject-matter jurisdiction of the Commission.

FOURTH DEFENSE

6. The complaint fails to set forth reasonable grounds for complaint, as required by R.C. 4905.26.

FIFTH DEFENSE

7. The complaint does not set forth a claim for which relief may be granted.

SIXTH DEFENSE

8. DEO at all times complied with the Ohio Revised Code Title 49; the applicable rules, regulations, and orders of the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio; and the Company's tariffs. These statutes, rules, regulations, orders and tariff provisions bar Complainants' claims.

SEVENTH DEFENSE

9. DEO reserves the right to raise other defenses as warranted by discovery in this matter.

WHEREFORE, DEO respectfully requests an Order dismissing the complaint and granting it all other necessary and proper relief.
