

- (7) On January 19, 2016, Complainant and Respondent together filed a joint motion to dismiss this complaint without prejudice, based on Complainant's claim that she is unable to pursue her complaint any further at this time.
- (8) The Commission finds that the parties' joint motion to dismiss the complaint in this case should be granted. Accordingly, this case should be dismissed, without prejudice, and closed of record.


It is, therefore,




