ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) Staff served a notice of preliminary determination upon John Larrow in accordance with Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-12, alleging a violation of the Commission's transportation regulations.
- (2) On January 15, 2016, Mr. Larrow filed a request for an administrative hearing in accordance with Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-13.
- (3) By Entry on March 8, 2016, a hearing was scheduled for April 21, 2016, at 10:00 a.m., at the offices of the Commission, 180 East Broad Street, 11th floor, Hearing Room 11-C, Columbus, Ohio 43215-3793.
- (4) On April 7, 2016, Mr. Larrow contacted the attorney examiner requesting a continuance. Mr. Larrow stated he is travelling from out of state and needed additional time to make travel accommodations.
- (5) The attorney examiner finds good cause to grant the motion to continue the hearing. Accordingly, the hearing should be continued until June 20, 2016, at 1:00 p.m, at the offices of the Commission, 180 East Broad Street, 11th Floor, Hearing Room 11-C, Columbus, Ohio 43215-3793.
- (6) Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-14(E), provides that a respondent who requests an administrative hearing and fails to participate in the hearing proceeding shall be in default. The rule additionally states that a respondent in default shall be deemed to have admitted the occurrence of the violation and waived all further right to contest liability to the state for the forfeiture described in the notice.

- (7) At the hearing, Staff must prove, by a preponderance of the evidence, that Respondent committed the alleged violations, pursuant to Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-20(A).

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That a hearing be held June 20, 2016, at 1:00 p.m., at the offices of the Commission, 180 East Broad Street, 11th floor, Hearing Room 11-C, Columbus, Ohio 43215-3793. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon each party of record.
