ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) On November 30, 2009, the Conesville Generating Station Unit 3 (Conesville 3) filed an application for certification as an eligible Ohio renewable energy resource generating facility, as defined by R.C. 4928.01(A)(37). Conesville 3 submitted for certification a 165 Megawatt (MW) facility, which was to be converted to co-fire biomass energy materials along with coal or natural gas. On April 1, 2010, Certificate No. 10-BIO-OH-GATS-0105 was issued with an effective date of March 31, 2010.
- (2) On January 22, 2016, Staff filed a Staff Report in this case recommending that the certificate be revoked as the generating facility has been deactivated. Staff notes that Conesville 3 filed a generator deactivation request with PJM and the unit has been deactivated.¹
- (3) Accordingly, the Commission finds that Certificate No. 10-BIO-OH-GATS-0105 should be revoked and this case be dismissed and closed of record.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That Certificate No. 10-BIO-OH-GATS-0105 be revoked and this case be dismissed and closed of record, in accordance with Finding (3). It is, further,
