### [EXPEDITED CONSIDERATION REQUESTED]

Ohio Edison Company, The Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company, and The Toledo Edison Company (the "Companies") respectfully request a 25 day extension of time, through and including May 26, 2016, to file tariffs consistent with the Commission's Opinion and Order dated March 31, 2016 ("ESP Order"). This extension is needed to allow the Companies to consider and address the Order recently issued by Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("FERC") which may impact this proceeding.

As the ESP Order originally anticipated a tariff filing by May 1, 2016, the Companies respectfully request an expedited ruling on this Motion pursuant to OAC 4901-1-12(C).

# MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT OF OHIO EDISON COMPANY, THE CLEVELAND ELECTRIC ILLUMINATING COMPANY, AND THE TOLEDO EDISON COMPANY'S MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE TARIFFS

## [EXPEDITED CONSIDERATION REQUESTED]

In the ESP Order the Commission made several findings regarding the Companies tariffs.

Most relevant here, the Commission held that:

The Companies shall file tariffs by May 1, 2016. With its initial filing and annually thereafter, FirstEnergy will provide to Staff customer bill impacts and proposed rate mitigation measures, if necessary.<sup>1</sup>

After the Commission made this determination, FERC issued an order which may affect

this proceeding on April 27, 2016 (the "FERC Order").<sup>2</sup> The FERC Order specifically addressed

this proceeding and made several findings which may impact this proceeding. Among other

things, the FERC Order held the Companies have "captive customers" and that the proposed

purchase power agreement with FirstEnergy Solutions Corp. was subject to FERC review.

As the FERC Order was not issued until the evening of April 27, 2016, the Companies have not yet had an opportunity to fully analyze the FERC Order and determine how the FERC Order may impact the tariffs which the ESP Order instructed be filed by May 1, 2016.
