Subject: Proposed Duke Energy gas pipeline through northern suburbs of Cincinnati

I am opposed to the currently proposed siting of the gas pipelines through the northern suburbs of Cincinnati. The problem with all three of the options I have seen proposed is that they come too close to private residences and public facilities in a way that will expose too many citizens to the risks associated with the pipelines. I think it is possible to find alternate routes which pass further away from population concentrations thereby reducing the risk. I recommend that you require Duke to choose such an alternative.

I have had personal experience with the risks associated with Duke Energy replacing underground utilities in my yard in the last year. A sinkhole was subsequently occurred and I fell into it sustaining substantial injuries when the ground in my yard fell out from under me. Duke Energy has refused to accept responsibility for the damages.

Therefore,I do not trust Duke to mitigate the risks associated with their latest proposal and think they should not be allowed to dig so close to residences, schools, and other public facilities. I do wish to point out that the plans as currently proposed do not place them "in my backyard" but I support the concerns of the other citizens who oppose the proposals and face these risks if the proposal is implemented.
