I'd like to echo my wife's concerns listed below regarding the safety and security of running a high pressure gas line through residential areas and especially if the proposed / designated route goes anywhere by any schools. We specifically moved into Blue Ash as a family in December 2015 to send our child to Sycamore Community Schools with Blue Ash Elementary being our first stage in that process. Having potentially hazardous and dangerous gas infrastructure so close to young students (and/or homes) is unacceptable in my opinion and has caused us to consider alternative means of education and potential relocation to ensure our child's safety.
