I am registering my opposition to this project.

Duke energy is proposing to run a massive 720-psi high pressure pipeline through densely populated neighborhoods in Ohio. There have already been 2 massive explosions, one in California and one in Pennsylvania.

It makes no sense to run a pipeline of this type through densely populated areas where an accidental explosion would kill or maim thousands. If this pipeline is necessary to keep Ohio looking at future energy needs, it should be run through rural areas where an accident would do much less damage to people, structures like homes, schools, and hospitals, and the vast infrastructure of cities. The potential for devastating much of our city is just too great a risk.

Please step up and demand that high pressure gas transmission lines be run away from densely populated areas. Please say NO to the Central Corridor Gas Pipeline Extension Project.
