I am a resident in Blue Ash, and am sending this email on behalf of Hamilton County residents along the proposed routes of the gas pipeline. The proposed routes not only go thru private property in Blue Ash, they are close to schools, hospitals, shopping centers. Duke held an open house and the reps were very evasive about what the proposed projects involve, but made it clear that they have the right to use eminent domain to take land and place a 30" pipeline in the ground. This would not only affect the safety of the area, it would greatly depreciate the land value. And this proposed route is going from Mason to Norwood. Why can't a remote area be used, which would not impact the safety of thousands of residents??? As a member of NOPE, I am requesting that you reject the proposals by Duke Energy.

I assume you will be acting in our interest when you make your final decision.
