Thank you for reading my concerns. The communities along these proposed routs are heavily populated. Even a minor gas leak has the possibility of seriously injuring people and an explosion will likely kill many people. Duke says their first concern is safety. It is impossible to actually think that this is the safest route for this very high pressure gas transmission line. Especially when there is open land, sparsely populated, just a few miles east of these communities.

Cincinnati and Hamilton county does not need this much additional natural gas. I could not find evidence that we do.. Duke is not willing to disclose how these communities were selected or to document the need for a 30 inch transmission line through this heavily populated area.

Please put the safety of the citizens of these communities before the convenience and profits of Duke..
