I wish to express my disapproval for the natural gas pipeline, case 16-0253-GA-BTX. There are quite a few issues with the proximity of all of the proposed paths, here are a few: [1] We regularly see on the news what can happen in residential areas when there is a malfunction, explosion, health risks, etc. of natural gas and none of it is good. [2] You can see in our area how poorly Duke maintains it's utilities that are above ground and accessible, one can only imagine how neglectful they would be to something not as easy to access. [3] The construction would be long term and very disruptive in an already congested area. [4] Property values are going to decrease due to the removal of trees and grass and the risk of being located in such close proximity to the pipeline. Property values decreasing would lead to less tax income available to the community to adequately fund schools, emergency services, road maintenance, etc. [5] Other energy sources are becoming increasingly more available which will reduce the need for such infrastructure, so why should the citizens have to sacrifice for Duke to make small gains?
