Certification of Compliance with Applicable Service Quality Standards and Consumer Protection Rules

Service Quality Standards

The Company:

- Provides voice grade access to the public switched network.
- Provides flat rated local exchange service with no additional charge to end users.
- Provides access to the emergency services provided by local government or other public safety organizations, such as 911 and enhanced 911.
- Provides toll blocking and toll limitation services.
- Advertises the availability of its services and the charges using media of general distribution and on its website.
- Maintains a business office providing customers with access to a customer service representative either in person or via a local telephone call or toll-free telephone number during normal business hours
- Directs after hour calls to the Company's help desk.
- Directs trouble reports to the on-call technician.
- Tracks all service orders to ensure they are completed in a timely manner.
- Measures its service connection and service interruption performance on a regular basis.
- Trains employees to:
 - o Answer all incoming calls promptly.
 - o Respond to all inquiries for information promptly and courteously.
 - Investigate thoroughly all customer complaints and handle appropriately according to the Company's guidelines for resolution of customer complaints.
 - Be knowledgeable about products and service offerings so they can assist the customer with selecting the best service option.
- Has a process for periodic inspection, testing and preventive maintenance of its equipment to permit the rendering of safe, adequate and continuous service at all times.

Consumer Protection Rules

The Company has established operating procedures designed to facilitate compliance with applicable consumer protection rules which include compliance with the Customer Proprietary Network Information (CPNI) rules. The operating procedures include:

- Appointment of a compliance officer.
- A manual detailing the specific procedures for protecting consumer information.
- Employee training on an annual basis.
- A disciplinary process for improper use of consumer information.

Functionality in Emergency Situations

Back-Up Power

The Arthur Mutual Telephone Company has electronic equipment at its Central Office and four remote locations through its exchange area. The Arthur Central Office houses a MetaSwitch 2510 switch as well as Fiber To The Home (FTTH) and legacy Copper access equipment. The four remote locations are 8'x10' permanent concrete block structures that contain FTTH and Copper access equipment.

The Central Office has battery and generator backup. The 100 amp DC Central office load is supported by A 40 KW propane generator that starts automatically in the event of a Commercial power outage. The generator normally starts in less than 10 seconds and power is supplied by stationary batteries while the generator is going online. The batteries provide approximately 8 hours of backup power if the generator does not start.

The remote sites are equipped with battery backup that provides at least 8 hours of power during commercial power interruptions. For extended power outages portable generators are brought on site.

Rerouting of Traffic around Damaged Facilities

Buried cable is used for all outside plant facilities to transport interexchange traffic. This reduces the chance of damage due to wind and ice. Telephone toll circuits as well as Broadband connectivity out of the Arthur exchange are on Fiber Optic facilities and provisioned in a ring configuration to accommodate rerouting of traffic.

Traffic Spikes

There are currently no equipment limitations on calls originating and terminating within the Arthur exchange. Calls to other exchanges are limited by the number of circuits that are in service between the Arthur office and the destination office. There are four exchanges that Arthur customers can call at no charge and the number of circuits to each exchange varies from 24 to 144. Call blocking would depend on the amount of calls placed simultaneously to each individual exchange. There are 72 toll calling circuits so blocking could occur during busy call times.

Lifeline Terms and Conditions

Arthur Mutual Telephone Company offers Lifeline program-supported service to qualified low-income residential consumers for one telephone line per eligible household. The Lifeline program provides discounts to eligible low-income consumers to help them establish and maintain telephone service. Lifeline assistance lowers the cost of basic, monthly local telephone service. Eligible consumers can receive \$9.25 per month in discounts. In addition, the Federal Universal Service Charge is not assessed to consumers participating in Lifeline. Toll Blocking prevents the placement of all long distance calls for which a subscriber would be charged. Toll blocking is available to eligible consumers at no cost. Also, by choosing this option, consumers are usually not charged a deposit.

Lifeline Program Eligibility Information

Program Based Eligibility

Consumers are eligible for Lifeline if they, one of their dependents or their household participate in one of the following qualifying assistance programs:

Medicaid

Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP, formerly Food Stamps) Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
Federal Public Housing Assistance (Section 8)
Low Income Housing Energy Assistance (LIHEAP)
Ohio Works First/Temporary Aid to Needy Families (TANF)
National School Lunch Free Program
Head Start

Lifeline applicants must present documentation demonstrating eligibility either through participation in one of the qualifying federal assistance programs or through income-based means.

Acceptable documentation of program-based eligibility includes: current or prior year's statement of benefits from a qualifying state, federal or Tribal program; notice letter of participation in a qualifying state, federal or Tribal program; program participation documents; or another official document evidencing the consumer's participation in a qualifying state, federal or Tribal program.

Income Based Eligibility

In addition, consumers are eligible for Lifeline if their household income is at or below 135% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines. The 2016 Federal Poverty Guidelines are attached to this document.

Acceptable documentation of income eligibility includes: prior year's state, federal or Tribal tax return; current income statement from an employer or paycheck stub; social security statement of benefits; Veterans Administration statement of benefits; retirement/pension statement of benefits; unemployment/workmen's compensation statement of benefits; federal or Tribal notice of letter participating in General Assistance; or a divorce decree or child support award or other official document containing income information.

Numbers of Minutes-of-Use Provided as Part of Lifeline Program Service

Arthur Mutual Telephone Company's Voice Lifeline service includes unlimited local minutes-of-use within the toll-free calling area. Arthur Mutual Telephone Company's Voice Lifeline Plan does not include any free minutes-of-use for toll. Toll is billed at the standard toll rate depending on which interexchange carrier the consumer subscribes to for toll service. As part of the Lifeline service, Toll blocking is available to eligible consumers at no cost.

Rates

Subscribers may receive the Lifeline credit on any type or grade of local service, including bundled services that are normally offered by Arthur Mutual Telephone Company. Advertised rates do not include any applicable taxes or surcharges.

Recertification of Lifeline Eligibility

Lifeline recipients are required to recertify their eligibility annually. Failure to properly recertify a recipient's continued eligibility for the Lifeline program will result in termination of the Lifeline recipient's monthly Lifeline discount and de-enrollment from the Lifeline Program.

Additional Lifeline Program Information

The Lifeline program is limited to one benefit per household, consisting of either wireline or wireless service. A household is defined, for purposes of the Lifeline program, as an individual or group of individuals who live together at the same address and share income and expenses. Lifeline is a government benefit program, and consumers who willfully make false statements in order to obtain the benefit can be punished by fine or imprisonment or can be barred from the program.

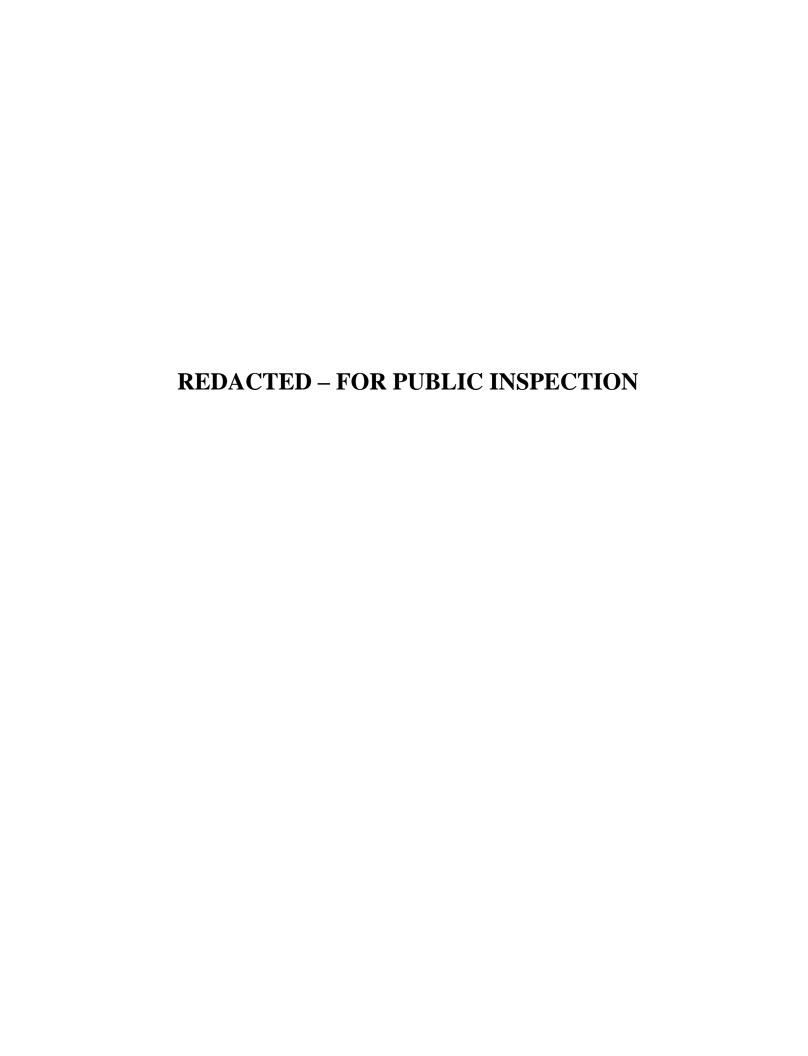


