Dear Ohio Power Siting Board,

I am writing in reference to the proposed gas transmission line by Duke Energy (OPSB case number 16-0253-GA-BTX).

It is an outrage that Duke is considering placing a high volume high pressure gas transmission pipeline in the middle of urban, heavy populated areas. This gas transmission line will have a very high pressure of 720 psi. Should there be an accident, the outcome will be catastrophic. The destruction zone will be ~1800ft around an accident.

The danger and threat from an accident is too great (i.e. the explosion in California and Pennsylvania). The risk to our children, home, schools, hospitals, first responders, churches is too great to justify this experiment of Duke Energy. Vital services would be compromised and there has been no assessment of the storm water impact in our communities.

Please help us and say no to the Central Corridor Gas Pipeline Extension project. We stand firmly opposed to this proposal.
