Re: In the Matter of the Application of The Dayton Power and Light Company for Approval of its Electric Security Plan, et al., Case No. 12-426-EL-SSO, et al.

The Ohio Manufacturers' Association Energy Group (OMAEG) respectfully requests that the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio (Commission) act immediately to address the June 21, 2016 Motion of Industrial Energy Users-Ohio and The Office of the Ohio Consumers' Counsel for an Order Vacating the Authorization of the Service Stability Rider (SSR) and Request for Expedited Ruling (Motion).

In light of the Ohio Supreme Court's recent decision which vacated the Commission's approval of the Dayton Power and Light Company's SSR, it is imperative that the Commission take expeditious action to ensure that customers are paying lawful charges that are just and reasonable as required by Section 4905.22, Ohio Revised Code. To the extent the Commission is unable to immediately address the Motion, the Commission should alternatively issue an entry directing that collection of the SSR be made subject to refund until the issues presented in the Motion are resolved.
