{¶ 1} On May 25, 2016, Godman Guild filed an application in accordance with Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-40-04(F) for certification as an Ohio renewable energy resource generating facility, as defined in R.C. 4928.01.

{¶ 2} Pursuant to Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-40-04(F), Godman Guild's application is subject to a 60-day automatic approval process. Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-40-04(F) further provides that, upon good cause shown, the Commission may suspend the certification of an application. If an application for certification is suspended, the Commission shall act to approve or deny the application within 90 days of the suspension.

{¶ 3} The attorney examiner finds that good cause exists to suspend the 60-day automatic approval process with respect to Godman Guild's application for certification, in order that the Commission and Staff may review this matter further.

{¶ 4} It is, therefore,

{¶ 5} ORDERED, That the automatic approval process for Godman Guild's application be suspended. It is, further,

{¶ 6} ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon Godman Guild and any other parties of record in this case.
