I also ask that you consider eliminating the Partial Service Schedule for distributed generation projects. Contrary to the supposed justification for this schedule, distributed generation will reduce the need for additional transmission facilities. This is because the capacity available from a single large generator drops by 100% when it goes offline (Think Davis-Besse 2002-2004.) but the same capacity provided by 100 small generators will not vary more than about 5% even if several generators go offline at the same time. The long-distance transmission capacity to back up the big generator is 100% of capacity, but for the group of small generators it is maybe 5% or 6% of capacity. As the number of small generators increases, the backup requirements decrease as a percent of capacity.

Because generation capacity requirements are so tied to peak loads, I would suggest that generation that works inherently in phase with peak system loads stabilizes the grid and reduces back-up generation and long-distance transmission needs. This is obviously true of combined heat and power when the heat load is mainly HVAC. To a lesser degree it is also true of Solar. In these cases, the cost of the last mile of transmission for backup power to the customer facility is significantly less than the avoided costs for peaking generation and long-distance

transmission. Because these facilities could help the entire customer base avoid the cost of some of the enormous transmission lines currently planned, I suggest that a correct analysis will show that CHP and Solar projects should receive rebates rather than added charges. Some utilities fund distributed energy project so they can profit from them. They see where they need to be in the twenty-first century, and go there. FirstEnergy is trying to drag us back into the mid-twentieth century.

As to the argument that the customers should come to the rescue of FirstEnergy's bond rating, I have to wonder why it would be that that is in our best interest. In the 1950's, CEI was a reasonably priced and reliable utility whose good service added to the economic attractiveness of the region. I don't think that is true in 2016. While their experiences of 2002-2004 may have chastened them into doing a better job of running nuclear plants and of pruning near transmission lines, They also had longstanding inefficiencies in how they ran coal fired plants, and has last week showed, their local distribution system is easily brought down by severe weather, leading to their outage tracking system being overwhelmed. By sixty hours into the outage they had no idea which customers had power restored. In short, it would be better for our region for FirstEnergy to be taken over by a stronger, better managed utility.
