FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME IN WHICH TO ACTIVATE TELEPHONE NUMBERING RESOURCES

MCImetro Access Transmission Services d/b/a Verizon Access Transmission Services ("Verizon") respectfully requests an extension of time in which to activate one thousands-block of telephone numbers assigned to it in the Barnesville, Ohio rate center. The thousands-block in question, 740-619-3XXX, was assigned by the Pooling Administrator (Neustar) on February 22, 2016. The due date for submitting confirmation of "in service" to the Pooling Administrator is August 22, 2016. Due to delays in processing a local order for the major customer that will use the assigned number block, Verizon will be unable to meet the deadline for activating customer DIDs and submitting the "in-service" confirmation. However, the customer has executed the contract, and Verizon anticipates that it will be able to turn up service to the customer within the next 90 days.

Reclamation of the numbers would cause Verizon and the major customer in question significant hardship. To ensure service will be available for this customer, and that Verizon's current available numbering resources do not become subject to reclamation. Verizon requests

an extension of 90 days in which to place the affected telephone numbering resources into service and provide confirmation to the Pooling Administrator. Verizon submits that an extension of time in which to activate the numbering resources is reasonable and appropriate in view of the limited duration of the requested extension and the expectation that the numbering resources will have an immediate and identifiable use.

WHEREFORE, Verizon respectfully requests that its motion for a 90-day extension of the August 22, 2016 due date for submitting "in-service" confirmation to the Pooling Administrator be granted.
