## APPLICATION TO CANCEL CERTIFICATE OF CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY AND SUBSTITUTE SERVICE

Now comes Camplands Water LLC, an Ohio for profit corporation (hereinafter "Camplands") by its delegate, Dean Bullard, system operator, who hereby files on behalf of Camplands this Application to Cancel Certificate No. 16 and Substitute Service.

Camplands Water LLC has been sold to the Village of Andover. The Village of Andover took over operations March 15, 2016. Pursuant to Sections 4901:1-15-05 (B) and (C) and 4901:1-15-08 Ohio Administrative Code, Camplands respectfully requests that the Commission grant its Application to Cancel its Certificate No. 16 and to Substitute Service and for any and all further relief to which it may be entitled.

## MEMORANDUM

## A. Background

- Camplands is a regulated water supply company servicing a customer base of 3 customers in and around Andover and Richmond Townships, Ashtabula County, OH.
- Camplands is the present certificate holder of Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity for a waterworks company issued by the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio ("PUCO") on or about June 23, 1974 and amended February 9, 1978, and designated as Certificate Number 16 (the "Certificate").
- 3) Camplands has been sold to the Village of Andover ("Village") and the Village took over operations on March 15, 2016.

- 4) In connection with the consummation of such transfer, (i) Camplands must cancel the Certificate, and (ii) the Village was substituted for Camplands as the water service provider for the Service Area.
- 5) Since the transfer is a substitution of the water service provider for the customers of the Service Area (and not the abandoning of water service), the water service to the customers of the Service Area has been maintained and not diminished by the transfer to the Village. Further, the transfer was completed in a manner to enable the continuous, uninterrupted supply of water service to the customers of the Service Area.
- 6) All customers are continuing to receive service.
- 7) No additional notice to customers should be required as the Village and the customers have signed agreements.

## B. Actions Which Camplands is Requesting:

Camplands respectfully requests that the PUCO take the following actions:

- 1) That the PUCO grant this Application in its entirety for (i) the cancellation of the Certificate and (ii) the substitution of the water service provider for the Service Area from Camplands to the Village; and
- 2) That the PUCO grant (i) Camplands "Relief from Jurisdiction", (ii) that Camplands be removed from the rolls of the PUCO regarding all of the customers in the Service Area, and (iii) any and all further relief to which Camplands may be entitled.
