MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT OF MOTION OF OHIO EDISON COMPANY, THE CLEVELAND ELECTRIC ILLUMINATING COMPANY, AND THE TOLEDO EDISON COMPANY TO STRIKE A PORTION OF THE POST-HEARING BRIEF OF THE INDEPENDENT MARKET MONITOR

I. INTRODUCTION

In the third full paragraph on the second page of its brief, the IMM relies upon information that is not in the evidentiary record in this case. Specifically, the IMM cites and discusses a portion of Company witness Mikkelsen's Rehearing Testimony that was stricken by Ms. Mikkelsen on the stand at the evidentiary hearing. (Rehearing Tr. Vol. I, p. 46.) Because this information is not part of the record before the Commission, it should have no bearing on the Commission's consideration of the parties' positions in this case. Accordingly, the Commission should grant this motion to strike.

II. EXCLUDED INFORMATION OR EVIDENCE NOT IN THE RECORD MAY NOT BE RELIED UPON ON BRIEF.

In its March 31, 2016 Opinion and Order in this proceeding, the Commission granted the Companies' motions to strike portions of several intervenors' briefs due to their reliance on information outside of the evidentiary record. (March 31, 2016 Opinion and Order ("March 31 Order"), p. 37.) In so ruling, the Commission noted that "parties should not rely upon evidence which has been stricken from the record." (*Id.*)

On page 2 of its brief, the IMM cites and discusses a portion of Ms. Mikkelsen's Rehearing Testimony that Ms. Mikkelsen struck on the stand during her direct testimony at rehearing. (IMM Br., p. 2, n. 5 (citing Mikkelsen Rehearing Testimony, p. 15:8-14); Rehearing Tr. Vol. I, p. 46 (striking Mikkelsen Rehearing Testimony beginning at p. 15:3 and continuing through p. 16:12).) Accordingly, the IMM may not rely upon stricken testimony in its brief.

For this reason, the Commission should grant the Companies' motion to strike the second sentence of the third full paragraph on page 2 of the IMM's brief, beginning with the word "Although" and ending with the words "charge/credit" and footnote 5.

III. CONCLUSION

For the foregoing reasons, the Commission should grant the Companies' motion to strike.
