{¶ 1} On August 16, 2016, the City of Delphos (Delphos) filed a motion for an extension of time from the date of certification expiration of July 21, 2016, to file its renewal application for certification as a competitive retail electric service governmental aggregator in the state of Ohio. Thereafter, on August 17, 2016, the City of Delphos filed its renewal application for certification as a competitive retail electric service governmental aggregator in the state of Ohio.

{¶ 2} In accordance with R.C. 4928.08, as well as Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-24-10, Delphos's renewal application for certification is subject to a 30-day automatic approval process, or, in this case, until September 16, 2016.

{¶ 3} The attorney examiner finds that Delphos's motion is reasonable and should be granted. Accordingly, Delphos's certification as a competitive retail electric service governmental aggregator shall remain effective through and until the Commission makes a determination on its renewal application for certification as a competitive retail electric service governmental aggregator in the state of Ohio.

{¶ 4} It is, therefore,

{¶ 5} ORDERED, That Delphos's motion for extension of time to file a renewal application for certification as a competitive retail electric service governmental aggregator in the state of Ohio be granted. It is, further,

{¶ 6} ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon each party of record.
