REVIEW AND RECOMMENDATION

THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF OHIO

On September 6, 2016, LDL Telecom Services, Inc. (Applicant) filed an application to abandon all telecommunications services and relinquish its certificate 90-9269 pursuant to Ohio Adm. Code 4901:1-6-26. The Applicant currently provides long distance service only and has 165 business subscribers. The Applicant has provided adequate customer notice in a variety of ways including US mail on August 22 and October 3, by email, and by telephone. The Applicant also provided a notice of discontinuance to the Federal Communications Commission on September 2, 2016. The Applicant intends to discontinue service in Ohio on October 15, 2016.

Absent full or partial suspension, certification applications will be approved in accordance with the thirty-day automatic approval process described in rule 4901:1-6-05 of the O.A.C. The Staff reviewed all documents and exhibits filed with this application and has determined that the proposed application appears to satisfy the Commission's requirements set forth in 4901:1-6-26 of the Ohio Administrative Code. Staff recommends that this application be approved on October 6, 2016. Upon approval of the application, Staff will ensure cancellation of the certificate no. 90-9269.
