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I have marked as Commission-ordered Exhibit No. 1 the Financial Audit of the Gas Cost Recovery Mechanisms for the Cost Incurred for the period of September 1, 2013 through August 31, 2015 for Suburban Natural Gas Company filed on July 29, 2016.

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I have marked as Commission-ordered Exhibit No. 2 the Audit of the Uncollectible Expense Mechanisms for period January 2014 through December of 2015 filed in Case No. 16-316-GA-UEX on July 29, 2016.

And Commission-ordered Exhibit No. 3, that is the Audit of the Percentage of Income Payment Plan for the period January 2014 through December 2015 filed in Case No. 16-416-GA-PIP on July 29, 2016.

And these, your Honor, correspond to the exhibits that are identified in Joint Exhibit No. 1, the Stipulation and Recommendation in this case.

THE ATTORNEY EXAMINER: Okay, thank you.

MR. MARGARD: Your Honor, may I approach?

THE ATTORNEY EXAMINER: Yes.

Q. (By Mr. Margard) Mr. Matthews, you are involved in the audits that resulted in the reports identified as Commission Exhibits 1, 2 and 3?

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A. Yes, sir.

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- Q. And to the best of your knowledge, those are accurate and there are no changes that need to be made to those records?
 - A. Yes, sir, that's correct.
- Q. I've placed before you Joint Exhibit
 No. 1, the Joint Stipulation and Recommendation. Are
 you familiar with this document?
 - A. Yes, sir, I am.
- Q. And were you involved in discussions -were you aware of the discussions between staff and
 the company that resulted in the Stipulation?
 - A. Yes, sir.
- Q. Were you aware of any other parties to this case or any other parties that were involved in those discussions?
- A. Outside of staff, no, sir.
- Q. So in your opinion did the parties engage in serious negotiations to reach the agreement?
- 20 A. Yes, sir.
 - Q. And do you believe this agreement benefits consumers and the public?
- 23 A. Yes, sir, I do.
- Q. In what manner do you believe it does so?
- 25 A. Yes, sir. Basically the findings of the

financial audits were that the company has accurately calculated their rates and accurately applied those rates to the customers' bills. That's one of the things we are looking for when they do the audits.

Another benefit is that there was a very small adjustment that would be in the favor of the GCR customers, and basically that was just related to some timing differences that was discovered in the procurement of gas for the customers.

- Q. In your opinion does this agreement violate any regulatory principles?
 - A. No, it doesn't.
- Q. And are you recommending that the Commission adopt the Stipulation and Recommendation?
 - A. Yes, sir.

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MR. MARGARD: Your Honor, those are all the questions for Mr. Matthews. Thank you.
