### ENTRY

Entered in the Journal on November 10, 2016

{¶ 1} Ohio Adm.Code Chapter 4901:1-39 provides that the Commission establish a procedural schedule for review of energy efficiency and peak demand reduction program portfolio plans. This matter is currently scheduled for hearing on December 1 and 2, 2016.

{¶ 2} On November 9, 2016, the Dayton Power and Light Company (DP&L or Company) filed a motion requesting that the hearing of this matter be rescheduled for December 21 and 22, 2016, with the deadline for filing of DP&L testimony and plan updates set to November 30, 2016, intervenor testimony due by December 14, 2016, and Staff testimony due by December 16, 2016. DP&L also requests expedited treatment of its motion under Ohio Adm. Code 4901-1-12(C), to allow the parties more time to engage in settlement negotiations. Further, the Company indicates that it has not received a response from each intervenor, but that Staff supports the motion and the majority of intervenors do not object to the granting of this motion.

{¶ 3} As it appears that no party will be unduly prejudiced by an expedited ruling on this motion or by the granting of the requested continuance, this matter will be rescheduled for hearing on December 21 and 22, 2016, in Hearing Room 11-D. Further, Company, intervenor, and Staff testimony will be due on November 30, December 14, and December 16, 2016, respectively.

{¶ 4} Finally, it appears that although the motion was captioned with both Case Nos. 16-649-EL-POR and 16-1369-EL-WVR, it was not e-filed in both dockets. For administrative ease, the Docketing Division should show the motion as filed in both dockets and relate these two cases on the system.

{¶ 5} It is, therefore,

{¶ 6} ORDERED, That the hearing of this matter be scheduled for December 21, 2016, at 10:00 a.m. in Hearing Room 11-D at the offices of the Commission. It is, further,

{¶ 7} ORDERED, That the parties observe the procedural schedule set forth above. It is, further,

{¶ 8} ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties of record.
