Dear Ms. McNeal:

Ohio Power Company (AEP Ohio) submitted its PPA rider Application in this case on December 7, 2016; the Application requested that the new PPA rate become effective with the first Billing Cycle of January 2017. To the extent that additional approval is required to include separate line items on customer bills for the Power Purchase Agreement and the 5% rate cap provision adopted in this case, AEP Ohio respectfully requests that the Commission approve these bill format changes on an expedited basis.

The new proposed bill format (attached) includes separate items for the Power Purchase Agreement and 5 Percent Rate Cap Credit. Although the billing system is programmed to implement the 5 percent credit if applicable the billing line item for the Power Purchase Agreement would include both the Power Purchase and 5 percent credit if applicable. AEP Ohio will include the 5 percent credit as a separate line item beginning with the first billing cycle of February (January 31, 2017).

AEP Ohio Messages

In Case No. 12-2627-EL-RDR, the PUCO approved an adjustment to increase the Distribution Investment Rider, effective with this bill. This rider, which is adjusted quarterly, recovers capital costs associated with distribution infrastructure. A residential customer using 1,000 kWh per month will see an increase of \$0.41 per month.

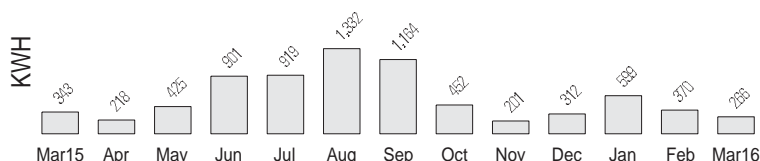
