{¶ 1} Ohio Adm.Code Chapter 4901:1-39 provides that the Commission establish a procedural schedule for review of energy efficiency and peak demand reduction program portfolio plans.

{¶ 2} This matter was scheduled for hearing on December 21, 2016, but will be continued by agreement of the parties until February 7, 2017 at 10:00 a.m. Further, any testimony in support of the Stipulation filed on December 13, 2016, should be filed by January 13, 2017, and any testimony in opposition to the Stipulation should be filed by January 30, 2017. The Dayton Power and Light Company will use its best efforts to respond to any discovery requests related to filed testimony in support of the Stipulation within five business days.
