{¶ 1} On October 6, 2016, TNE Telephone, Inc. (TNE) filed an application seeking authority to provide competitive local exchange telecommunications services in Ohio.

{¶ 2} Pursuant to Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-06-06(C), this application was suspended for 60 days by attorney examiner's entry issued November 3, 2016, so that additional information could be submitted and additional investigation could be done on this application.

{¶ 3} Additional information is still necessary in order to complete a review of the application. Therefore, pursuant to Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-6-06(C), this matter is being suspended from the automatic approval process and cannot now be approved without a Commission order. The applicant is instructed to contact Staff and supplement its application or its application in this matter will be recommended for dismissal.
