I. SUMMARY

{¶ 1} The Commission, nunc pro tunc, revises the Universal Service Fund rider rates of Ohio Edison Company and Duke Energy Ohio, Inc. listed in the December 21, 2016 Opinion and Order.

II. DISCUSSION

{¶ 2} On October 31, 2016, as amended on November 28, 2016, and November 29, 2016, the Ohio Development Services Agency (ODSA) filed its application, and supporting testimony, to adjust the Universal Service Fund (USF) riders of the jurisdictional electric utilities, Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company (CEI), Dayton Power & Light Company (DP&L), Duke Energy Ohio, Inc. (Duke), Ohio Edison Company (OE), Ohio Power Company (OP),¹ and Toledo Edison Company (TE), in accordance with the requirements of R.C. 4928.52.

¹ By Entry issued on March 7, 2012, the Commission approved and confirmed the merger of Columbus Southern Power Company (CSP) with OP, effective December 31, 2011. *In re AEP Ohio*, Case No. 10-2376-EL-UNC, Entry (Mar. 7, 2012). The USF rates of OP and CSP have not been consolidated. *In re ODSA*, Case No. 15-1046-EL-USF, Opinion and Order (Oct. 28, 2015).

{¶ 3} On November 30, 2016, a Joint Stipulation and Recommendation (2016 Adjustment Stipulation) was filed by ODSA, OE, CEI, TE, DP&L, OP and Industrial Energy Users-Ohio to resolve all the issues raised in the adjustment application. On December 6, 2016, ODSA filed an amendment to the 2016 Adjustment Stipulation to include OP as a signatory party.

{¶ 4} By Opinion and Order issued December 21, 2016, the Commission adopted the unopposed 2016 Adjustment Stipulation. The Opinion and Order included certain provisions of the 2016 Adjustment Stipulation and a chart of the USF rider rates agreed to by the signatory parties on page 12. The chart in the Opinion and Order listed the incorrect rates for OE and Duke. Consistent with the rates stated in the stipulation, the proposed USF rider rates for OE and Duke should have been as follows:

EDU	First 833,000 Kwh	Above 833,000 Kwh
Duke	\$ 0.0002896	\$ 0.0002896
OE	\$ 0.00014456	\$ 0.0010461

{¶ 5} In all other respects, the December 21, 2016 Opinion and Order remains in full force and effect.

{¶ 6} On December 21, 2016, OE and Duke filed their respective USF compliance tariffs which reflected the appropriate USF rates.


{¶ 7} It is, therefore,




